

Volunteering for Swim Meets

Summer league swim programs are made possible by the volunteer time of all parents. We need approximately 60 workers to run a smooth and successful swim meet. Please read over the different jobs and decide which job(s) you would be willing to help with during a swim meet.

We ask that each family provide at least 1 volunteer for half of the meet; however, if you can volunteer for more that is great with us! *Please know that if you are new to the team, we will provide training for any of the jobs listed.*

How to volunteer:

- Click on volunteer
- Select the date of the event
- This will direct you to the website, sign up genius – you will need to register with this website the first time you use it.
- Select the job(s) you would like to volunteer for

Here are the different jobs during a swim meet:

Set up – Arrive at the pool at 4:00 to set up for the meet

Table Workers - Verifies swimmers times, sorts timing sheets

Announcer – Announces events during swim meet

Starter - starts each race

Seater - Place swimmers in correct order for each heat/event

Mites - Places 8 and unders in correct order for each heat/event

Runner - Runs time cards or DQ cards from pool deck to the table workers

Hospitality - Passes out water/lemonade to workers during the meet

Timer – Times each race using stopwatch and timing system

Strokes and Turn Judge - Ensures swimmers are swimming each stroke properly

Concession Stand – Sells snacks and drinks during the meet

Clean Up - Stay after home meets to help clean up
